GNAS shooting 70m round -There will be four archers per boss - double detail.

**Any lost arrows will be recovered at the end of the 70m round. Help will be given to any archer by the Field Party during the lunchtime interval prior to the start of the Head 2 Head. As soon as the field is clear there will be a period for practice before the Head 2 Head element commences.**

**GNAS dress regulations apply (rule 307)**

**Awards:** These will be awarded subject to the minimum entry of:  
1-2 Gold, 3 - Gold and Silver, 4 + Gold, Silver and Bronze  
Double 70 m round Recurve / Compound - Ladies and Gents  
Individual H2H Recurve / Compound:- Ladies and Gents

**Drug Testing:** Archers at this tournament may be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply.

Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian giving consent for a drug test, if sought, to be carried out.

**Photography:** Anyone wishing to take photographs must register with the organiser

**Raffles:** A raffle will be held at the end of shooting on Saturday and before the awards on Sunday

**All archers are requested to help clear the field at the end of the shoot.**

**All Affiliation cards will be inspected.** Archers, who cannot show a GNAS card, receipt or membership of a FITA affiliated association will **NOT BE PERMITTED TO SHOOT.**

## Directions

From Tyne Tunnel:

Take A187 Wallsend for approx 3 miles onto Fossway. At traffic lights next to Turbinia Pub turn left onto Westbourne Avenue. After  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile turn right into Middle Street. Turn right after 450 yards into Langley Road. The field is 60 yards on, on the right.

From Tyne Bridge:

Take A193 off Central Motorway onto Shields Road. Over Byker Bridge take bypass. Turn right at roundabout past B&Q onto Fossway. Turn right at Turbinia Pub onto Westbourne Avenue and follow directions above.

# The 'Mauritania'

## 70M (WRS) plus Head 2 Head

All competitors are asked to register before equipment inspection/practice on both days, at which time they will be able to confirm their target allocation. Please bring GNAS (or other FITA member association) cards as proof of membership.

For all competitors the entire competition will be shot at 70m on the 122 cm face. At the end of the ranking round the Head 2 Head competition will generally take place on the targets to the left of the Director of Shooting's (DoS) tent.

Any unused targets to the right of the DoS's tent will usually be available for practice, and will follow the same time control as the competitive matches.

Official practice will be available on all targets between the ranking and elimination rounds under the control of the DoS.

### **The HEAD 2 HEAD**

The Head 2 Head tournament involve several rounds of knockout matches, where winning archers advance through a series of first Elimination rounds and subsequently Finals round matches, culminating in the Bronze, Silver and Gold Medal Finals.

All archers competing in each day's ranking round will all have the opportunity to participate in the Head 2 Head round.

When the ranking round scores have been checked and sorted each archer will be issued with an H2H round score sheet which will show their ranking. This will specify which targets they will use, for the remainder of the competition.

Competitors who are not involved in a particular stage of the competition (e.g. archers with compound bows at a time when those with Recurve bows are shooting, for example), may not shoot on the competition targets, but will be permitted to use the practice targets under the control of the DoS. Preference will be given to those archers whose match commences next.

## INDIVIDUAL HEAD 2 HEAD

There will be four categories, men and women shooting Recurve or Compound bows. (Within each category, all archers will compete together regardless of age.)

Under the new FITA Rules for the Head 2 Head, matches will comprise of a series of sets. The winner of a set is the archer which has the highest score of the arrows shot for that set. The winner of the set gets two (2) points. If the score is tied both will receive one (1) point. The loser will receive no (0) points.

Up to the medal matches it will be the best of three (3) sets. Sets will comprise of six (6) arrow ends. If there is a tie after the third (3rd) set, a single arrow shoot off will be shot and the archer with the arrow closest to the centre will win.

Up to the medal matches the competition will be run by DoS, six arrows in four minutes, all archers to shoot simultaneously.

For the medal matches it will be the best of five (5) sets. Sets will comprise of three (3) arrow ends. Archers will shoot one arrow at a time in turn, with each match individually timed by a judge. The first archer has 30 seconds to shoot their first arrow. As soon as that archer has shot, the match judge indicates the start of the second archer's 30 second shooting period. The archers continue to alternate their shots in this fashion until each has shot 3 arrows. This will be the end of a set.

After a minimum of three (3) sets, the archer with the highest points is declared the winner of the match when his opponent can no longer tie with the remaining points. This will continue up to five (5) sets at which point a single arrow shoot off will be shot and the archer with the arrow closest to the centre will win.
