
How to find our outdoor venue

Enter the cricket ground from the A184 and follow the road to the main car park to the left of the pavilion. Further parking is available to your right as you enter ground from the main road if no spaces are available around the pavilion. The entrance gate to the archery field is behind the pavilion. **No parking is allowed on the field.** If you are using SatNav the postcode NE36 0BT should get you close.

Limited entry:

- Places will be on a first come first served basis together with payment. Those who wish to pay on the day will be entered if there is room depending on paid entries.
- Any archer unable to score, pull or retrieve arrows must bring a helper with them. Please notify the tournament organiser if you have any specific requirements e.g. relating to a disability. Let us know if you need a stool or wheelchair on the line.
- The tournament is open to any archer currently affiliated with Archery GB.
- > Archery GB dress code regulations shown in rule 307 will apply.
- > PRIORITY WILL BE GIVEN TO ARCHERS SHOOTING BOTH DAYS.

Drug testing:

Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and archers approached must comply with requests. If refused, the refusal will be taken as a positive result. Parents of juniors must countersign the entry form to give consent and allow juniors to be tested if needed.

Trophies and Awards

Only available to competitors entering both days and shooting the senior rounds.

Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Barebow - Gentlemen/Ladies all respectively:

1st Scores Trophies and Medals

2nd Scores Medal 3rd Scores Medal

Compound team:

3 highest scores male or female: Trophy and medals

Recurve team:

3 highest scores male or female: Trophy and medals

Distance awards:

Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Barebow - Gentlemen/Ladies all

respectively:

Highest Long Metric Highest Short Metric

Archers who receive 1st, 2nd and 3rd will not be eligible for distance awards.

Juniors: 1440 Round Juniors must shoot the senior rounds.

720 Rounds there is a 60m Junior distance available depending on entries, this round is not eligible for the above Trophy's or Medals.

Trophies: All trophies are returnable. Trophies to be held for one year only.

Please return them in a clean condition to the tournament organiser on the day of the shoot or by Guaranteed Post during the week

on the day of the shoot or by Guaranteed Post during the wee

beforehand.

Archers are awarded the trophies if they have the highest overall score for the weekend, regardless if they shoot 1 day or both days, if they have the highest score when the shoot is finished, they win.

A raffle will take place while results are being finalised.

In accordance with AGB's Child & Vulnerable Adult Policy anyone wishing to use any photographic, or image-capturing equipment, must notify the Tournament Organiser and sign the registration form available on the day.
