


How to find our indoor venue

Regulations:

- ▶ GNAS rules of shooting for a Non-Record Status FITA 25 Round will apply.
- ▶ Recurve, Longbow and Barebow will shoot on full size 60cm faces.
- ▶ Compound bows will shoot on **triple spot** faces (maximum of 2 archers per face).
- ▶ GNAS Dress Code, but Seasonal is optional.
- ▶ Entries limited to GNAS/FITA affiliates only.
- ▶ Juniors under 16 years of age must be accompanied at all times by their parent or guardian.
- ▶ Competitors may be required to produce their Archery GB cards on the day. Entrants without a current Archery GB Membership No. must have their entry form endorsed by their Club Secretary/Treasurer stating that they are fully paid members of Archery GB.

FOOTWEAR:

Smooth soled indoor footwear must be worn.

Outdoor footwear on the bowling area is strictly forbidden by the B.C.A.

Trophies and Awards

Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Recurve Barebow*

Gentlemen/Ladies/Junior Gentlemen/Junior Ladies; all respectively:

1st Score Trophy & Medal

Most Golds Prize, and the Rudolph Prize (*most reds*)

*Other awards according to entry, 1st Barebow medal only**

Visually Impaired Archers:

1st Score Trophy & Medal

Novices and Veterans :

Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Recurve Barebow all respectively:

1st Score in each discipline Medal

No competitor may receive more than one award from the above.

Club Teams: Comprising up to three archers: Male or Female / Adults or Juniors.

All Recurve/Longbow/Recurve Barebow Archers:

1st Score Trophy & Medals

Compound Archers:

1st Score Trophy & Medals

Novice: An archer who has not competed in any Open Tournament.

Veteran: An archer 60 years of age or older.

Juniors: May enter the Senior categories on payment of appropriate fee, but in so doing will **not** qualify for the Junior awards. However, all Juniors may qualify for the Club Team Awards.

Trophies: All trophies are returnable Challenge Trophies to be held for one year only. Current holders are requested to return them, in a clean condition, to the Tournament Organiser on the day of the shoot or by Guaranteed Post during the week beforehand. Additional prizes may be awarded depending on entry.

In accordance with the GNAS Child & Vulnerable Adult Policy anyone wishing to use any photographic, or image-capturing equipment, must notify the Tournament Organiser and sign the registration form available on the day.

A target list will be available on our website www.cleadonarchers.co.uk after the closing date of Monday 3rd December 2018. Results will be posted shortly after the tournament.
