INSTRUCTIONS FOR STAFFORD ROUND

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS THESE ARE DIFFERENT TO ANY OTHER ROUND SHOT PREVIOUSLY AT GREEN LANE

After consultation with the TO and Judge in Charge, due to the limited space the following points must be made aware to all archers entering the shoot.

1. NO spectators will be allowed into the hall. There is a viewing gallery where they can sit and watch.
2. NO bow cases, bags to stay in the hall. A secure venue will be available to store your bags. Small bags that can fit under a normal chair will be allowed i.e. food bags.
3. All bows to be on bow stands.
4. 2nd session archers will not be allowed into the hall until 1st session is finished. Then only when instructed by the TO or Judge in Charge may they enter.
5. Parents are requested to ensure there child is under parental control at all times.

The success of this shoot will depend greatly on the good will of all attending.
