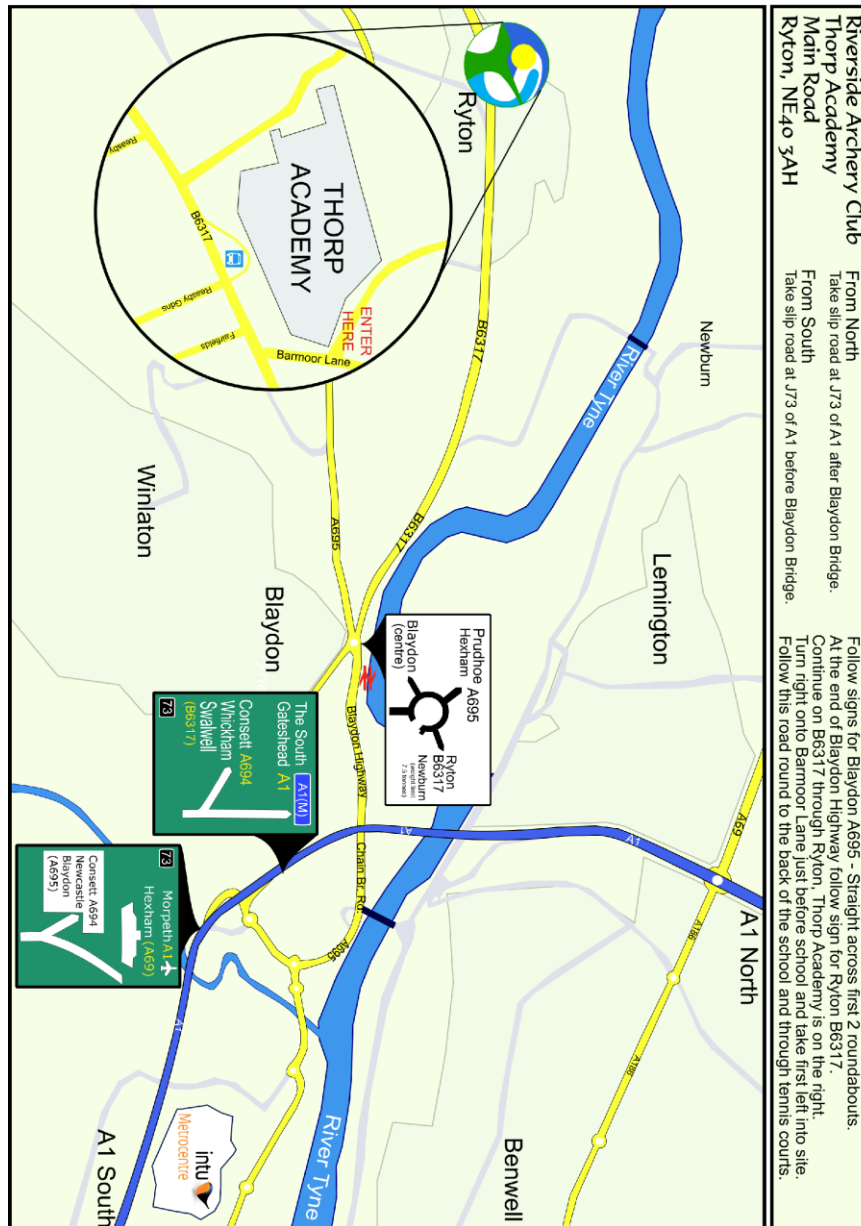

If you shoot any kind of bow without sights, ground markers or rubber bands whether it be a Barebow Recurve, American Flatbow, Asian Recurve (Horse Bow), Yumi or English Longbow then this could be a competition for you.

We hope to encourage anyone who shoots any type of barebow to come and try the Windsor round you are happiest shooting, (Windsor three dozen arrows each at 60, 50 and 40yds, Short Windsor 50, 40 and 30yds, Junior Windsor 40, 30 and 20yds or the Short Junior Windsor 30, 20 and 10yds) and have some fun with likeminded archers.

In an attempt at fairness between bow styles, we will have separate awards for each of the different styles entered at the different distances.
