Assembly: 11 am; Sighters 11:15 am; shooting commences 11:30 am 4 archers per target – double detail.

The rounds available are listed below with the distances and age categories that are listed in the rules of shooting.

A western round is two distances with four dozen arrows at each distance

WESTERN (60 yards and 50 Yards) Adult SHORT WESTERN (50 yards and 40 yards) Gents U16 Ladies U16 JUNIOR WESTERN (40 yards and 30 yards) Gents U14 and Ladies U14 SHORT JUNIOR WESTERN (30 yards and 20 yards) Gents U12 Ladies U12

The Organisers are aware that some Novices have not been shooting long. You may enter any of the rounds identified above, we would ask that you enter the round you feel comfortable shooting. We want you all to have fun and enjoy the day.

Juniors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by their parent/appointed guardian.

Awards: As entry warrants. Medals will be awarded for highest score, ties will be awarded under Rule 306 (s) (i).

Dress Code: AGB Rule of Shooting Number 307. Dress Regulations. Those not complying with the dress regulations will not be allowed to participate.

If you are unaware the rules stated above please read the Rules of Shooting.

Proof of AGB membership will be required at registration.

Disabled Archers: Please state if you need wheelchair or seating arrangements on the shooting line.

The term 'Novice' applies to DNAA members only and shall be defined as competitors who are currently in their <u>first</u> year of Archery GB Membership.

Entry Fee: £6

Closing date: 3 August 2019

No late entries. No entries on the day.

Refreshments will be available at "Carole's Café" throughout the competition. Bring your own lunch.

Please note that Dogs are not allowed on the Complex at all times. Guide dogs are allowed Please also ensure that all mobile phones are switched off or on silent before the commencement of shooting.

PARKING: Ample parking is available on the field, please follow the signs. Disabled archers please contact the Tournament Organiser for "preferred parking" and to request a wheelchair/stool space be allocated.

When you enter competitons the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitiors for example target lists and resusts may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone Number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
