Saturday : Ladies and Gents WA 1440, Metric 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, WA VI Outdoors (1440) Burntwood Round. Shooting will be in accordance with rule book 3. Juniors may enter the Senior Class (by paying the appropriate Senior Fee) but will not then qualify for the Junior Awards. Juniors under 16yrs must be accompanied by their parent/appointed guardian. Seniors may enter Junior Classes but will not then qualify for Senior Awards. Juniors entering their own age appropriate rounds will take entry priority.

Assembly : 8.30 am **Practice** : 8.45 am. **Shooting commences** : 9.30 am.

Rules:

- WA rules will apply.
- Shooting will be in accordance with rule 304 (f) (ii).
- The WA VI Burntwood round will consist of 3 dozen arrows at a 60am face, followed by 6 dozen arrows (in 2 sets of 3 dozen) at an 80cm face and 3 dozen arrows at an 122cm face all at 30m as per shooting for the rest of the field.
- Shooting at the 2 longer distances will be in ends of 6 arrows shot in 4 minutes.
- Shooting at the 2 shorter distances will be in ends of 6 arrows shot in 4 minutes on individual, 6 zone faces. Except for barebow and longbow archers who will shoot on a single, full size 80 cm face.
- There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details.
- **From 1st April 2022 Equipment failures are no longer applicable with the exception of junior aged entrants shooting metric rounds**
- Proof of Archery GB membership WILL be required at registration.

Awards : As entry warrants. Trophies and medals will be awarded for highest score, ties will be awarded under Rule 14.5.

Sunday : York, Hereford, Bristol and Burntwood (York/Hereford) rounds. Juniors may enter the Senior Class (by paying the appropriate Senior Fee) but will not then qualify for the Junior Awards. Juniors under 16yrs must be accompanied by their parent/appointed guardian. Seniors may enter Junior Classes but will not then qualify for Senior Awards. Juniors entering their own age appropriate rounds will take entry priority.

Assembly : 8.30 am Sighters : 8.45 am. **Shooting commences** : 9.00 am.

Rules:

- GNAS rules will apply.
- Shooting will be in accordance with rule 304 (f) (ii).
- Shooting will be in ends of 6 arrows shot in 4 minutes.
- The Burntwood rounds will consist of (York) 6 dozen arrows at a 40cm face, followed by 4 dozen arrows at a 60cm face and 3 dozen arrows at an 80cm face all at 30m and (Hereford) 6 dozen arrows at a 60cm face, followed by 4 dozen arrows at an 80cm face and 3 dozen arrows at an 122cm face all at 30m.
- There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details.
- Proof of Archery GB membership WILL be required at registration.

Awards : As entry warrants. Trophies and medals will be awarded for highest score, ties will be awarded under Rule 306 (s) (ii).
