Travel directions: -

- (1) From North (A1) - Traveling South on the A1 take the turn onto the A19 (SP Tyne Tunnel A19). At roundabout continue South towards Tyne Tunnel. Then (3).
- (2) From North (A189) - Traveling South on the A189 turn onto the A19 (SP A19 South). Continue South towards Tyne Tunnel. Then (3).
- (3) Turn off A19 (SP Killingworth and Backworth). At bottom of slip road turn **LEFT**, The (4).
- (4) At the T-junction turn **RIGHT** onto B1322.(SP Backworth). Continue through village (20 MPH) at mini roundabout turn **RIGHT**, After about 150m turn **RIGHT** into Backworth Hall, opposite the Backworth Club.. Then (7).
- (5) From South A19 (Tyne Tunnel - Toll £1.60 (car)) - Travel north on A19. Leave A19 for A181/A186 (SP Whitley Bay / Earsdon). At roundabout take the **Fourth** exit (SP Earsdon). At roundabout take first (Not the pub) exit (SP Earsdon). Proceed straight over next roundabout, first exit, (Not the pub). At next roundabout turn **LEFT** onto B1322. Proceed into 20 MPH zone. The entrance to Backworth Hall is on the **LEFT**, opposite the Backworth Club.. Then (7).
- (6) From South A1. Traveling, North, around Newcastle on the Western By-pass; leave the A1 (SP Wideopen and Killingworth A1056). Follow the A1056 past Killingworth to T-junction with the B1322. Then (4).
- (7) On entering the grounds of Backworth Hall (**Observe speed limit**) continue past the front of the hall and turn **LEFT** into the cinder park. Please use this car park. Overspill parking is available 40m to the left.

Arrangements can be made for Disabled Archers to park on the field.
