### Shooting

**Rounds:** York, Hereford, Bristols II-V. **Archers are encouraged to shoot distances at which they are comfortable.** However, county championship titles will only be presented at the recognized round for category.

Bristol III	50yds, 40yds, 30yds	U16/U15 Ladies, U15 Open
Bristol IV	40yds, 30yds, 20yds	U14 Ladies, U14 Open
Bristol V	30yds, 20yds, 10yds	U12 Ladies, U12 Open

**Sighters:** 1 end of sighters at 10:00  
**Timing:** Shooting at all distances will be in ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes. There will be up to 4 archers per boss, shooting double detail.



### General Information

Dress regulations will apply, as per ArcheryGB rule 307.

Drug testing: archers competing at record status tournaments may be subject to testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply; non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering this competition, you consent to testing, if you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor, this is in line with UK anti-doping policy rule 5.7.2

UK GDPR: when you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors – name, gender, bow style, age category, club round and disabled if applicable). Bosses to be used are layered foam. Well-behaved dogs are allowed behind the tent line.



### Awards

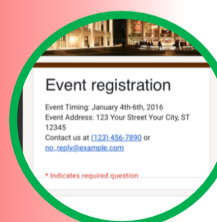
Individual county championship awards and titles will be awarded to those archers affiliated to Durham and Northumberland Archery Association. Senior (including 50+ and U21) archers shooting the York in the open category or Hereford for ladies are eligible for senior county championship awards and titles. Archers shooting the appropriate 50+ rounds are eligible for 50+ awards, but would not be eligible for the senior county championship titles and awards if shooting a shorter distance. Juniors shooting the York/Hereford rounds must state upon entry if they intend to shoot as a senior or a junior.

Team awards are available for teams of 3 archers for each of the following bow-types – recurve, compound, longbow and barebow.

Junior County Championship titles will be awarded to the archer(s) shooting a score equating to the lowest handicap. To be eligible, junior archers must shoot the appropriate round for their age group (or further). Note that juniors age category is as of 31Dec2026, ie a junior who turns 15 on 31Dec2026 should shoot in the U16 age group.

Visitor awards will be available for archers not affiliated to DNAA.

Rose awards are available to claim from this event, should score criteria be met.
